

The Old Growth Strategy

- Gain access to international markets
 through
 - WTO
 - Surplus labor in rural areas (low urban wages)
 - Low exchange rate
- To maximize employment
- Foster accumulation and technology transfer through FDI


A turning point?

- With recession China saw
 - Decline in exports
 - Growth deceleration
 - Increased unemployment
 - Signs of unrest

New Growth Strategy

- Wen Jibao new growth model to alleviate tensions in the system based on:
 - Growth of domestic demand to rely less on Net Exports
 - Reduce regional inequality (G directly mostly to rural areas)
 - An increasing military power to secure commodities needed to satisfy domestic demand
 - More efficient, more technology-intensive
 - Still controlled by the CCP
- But exports keep growing (a lot)
- Will the exchange rate policy adjust to the new strategy?
- Will the PBOC liberalize the banking sector?

The framework



China-US relationship

- Lost of manufacturing jobs...
- ... some going to China
- Large trade deficit...
- ... while China has a growing surplus
- China accumulates US bonds...
- ... while the US runs a large deficit
- And senator Schumer (DNY) complains about the exchange rate
