Promoting Inclusive Workplace

MBA students under the Talent Engagement and Inclusion (TEI) course recently organised the Neurodiversity Employment Campaign to disseminate the notion of making employment inclusive for the neurodiverse community. Neurodiverse people usually refer to those diagnosed with autism, attention deficit hyperactivity disorders (ADHD), Asperger, and dyslexia. The whole program involved a two-month social media campaign, an online petition, and one-day event highlight that featured speakers representing industry, NGO, neurodiverse individuals, and academic researchers. The program aimed to influence human resource practitioners, employers, and industry practitioners to provide opportunities that will facilitate entrance and inclusion of neurodiverse people into the workplace. Sixty participants had attended the event highlight, and over 1,100 people from 13 countries had pledged supports for the cause.
